Your key responsibilities:

- Interpretation of both anatomical (gross post mortem, histopathology) and clinical pathology results
- This includes evaluation and interpretation of haematology, cytology, biochemistry, endocrinology, urinalysis, serology, microbiology & molecular results
- Complete post-mortem exams on small and large animals
- Oversee preparation of tissue for testing
- Participation in the provision of services and advice to PIRSA
- Provision of specialist advice and phone consultation to veterinary clients
- Provide scientific leadership to the laboratory technical team through mentorship, audits, and assistance with laboratory electronic records management and reporting systems in accordance to NATA accreditation.
- Provide support to the Commercial team to consistently understand and meet the needs of our clients and participation in marketing activities to meet professional expectations.

Essential requirements
